

1st SSAI Training Programme in Advanced Emergency Medicine

The Scandinavian Society of Anaesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine (SSAI) co-ordinates an Inter-Nordic training programme in Advanced Emergency Medicine. The training programme lasts two years and consists of

- clinical training including working in an emergency medicine setting both in- and prehospital
- a four week exchange programme, preferably in another country
- Four SSAI courses in various Nordic countries

The course language will be English.

During the programme there will be mandatory assignments before and after the courses, including a master thesis.

Participants completing the 2-year Inter-Nordic training programme, the courses, the exchange programme and the master thesis will receive a SSAI Diploma in Advanced Emergency Medicine.

All expenses for this programme (including travelling, accommodation and a fee for each course) have to be covered by the host clinic. Other arrangement concerning finances has to be approved by the steering group. The total cost for the courses are estimated to about 7500 Euros, not including travel expenses. Applicants must be specialists in anaesthesiology with documented interest in emergency medicine. The applicants are selected according to their affiliation, academic merits, clinical skills and motivation by the discretion of the steering committee of the training programme. Specialists from other disciplines may apply for the programme, but 12 months of anaesthesia training before being accepted to the programme is mandatory. Membership in SSAI by the applicant is mandatory.
